#### Dear Parent/Guardian:

Each spring, our students participate in local and statewide testing, which includes APRENDA and the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) System. The APRENDA tests measure students' progress in Spanish language arts and math and will be administered to students in grades 3-8 who are enrolled in the Two-Way Bilingual Immersion Program. The tests in the CAASPP System provide information about students' progress and readiness for college and careers. In grades three through eight, our students take the Smarter Balanced online tests for English language arts/literacy (ELA) and mathematics. In grades five and eight students are also tested in science. This year's science test is a pilot and will not be scored.

OCEAA's testing dates for 2017 are scheduled on the following weeks; please make sure your students arrive on time!

- APRENDA = April 17-21 for 3rd-8<sup>th</sup> grade students in the dual immersion program
- California Science Test, 5<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades = May 1-5
- Smarter Balanced, 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grades = May 8-12 ELA and May 22-25 math
- Smarter Balanced, 4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grades = May 15-19 ELA and May 30-June 2 math
- Smarter Balanced, 3<sup>rd</sup> grade = May 15-19 math and May 30-June 2 ELA




#### **Enrollment**


