



Bilingual Elementary Classroom Teacher

The Orange County Educational Arts Academy (OCEAA) is a TK-8 independent charter school specializing in dual language immersion, arts education and technology integration. The school population is diverse; approximately 70% of students are low income, 50% are English Learners and 7% are Students with Disabilities. OCEAA partners with EL Education as a network school to create classrooms where students achieve content mastery in two languages and become active contributors to building a better world. *Applicants must be able to conduct lessons entirely in academic Spanish to students who are becoming bi-literate in Spanish and English.*

The bilingual elementary teacher is expected to: 1) take full responsibility for the achievement and engagement of every student every day; 2) collaborate deeply with parents and colleagues to raise student achievement, 3) be a leader in bringing about significant and lasting change in the classroom and school, 4) fully engage in professional development activities and coaching cycles to learn how to effectively implement the Core Practices of EL Education and Guiding Principles of Dual Language Education.
